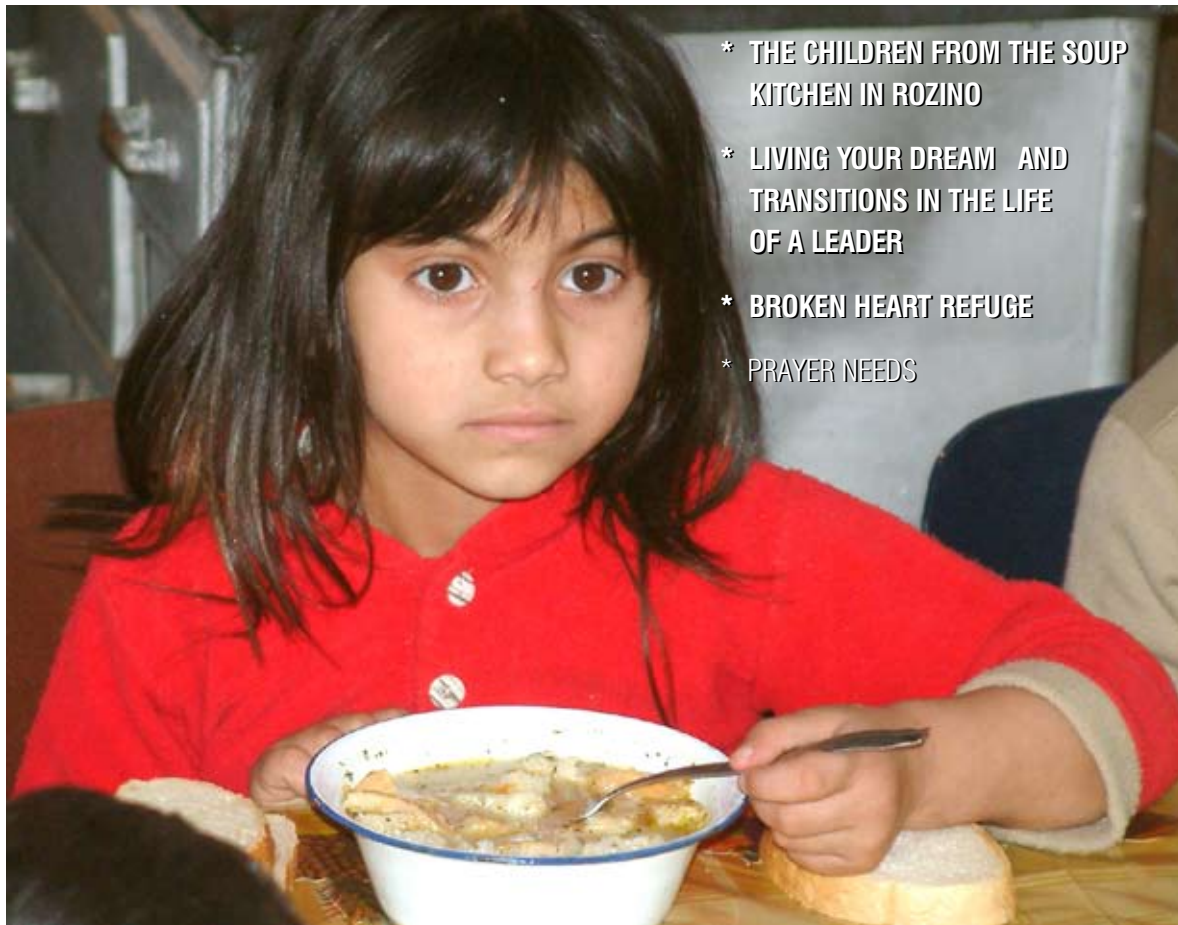

Have the pleasure (How pleasant it is) to visit every month the soup kitchen in Rozino. The road going there is beautiful, no matter what time of the year it is. The church in this small mountain village is always open and full of children. You can't even imagine that former Muslims are now happy to play in church, recite verses from the Bible and sing songs about the love of Jesus... When they are sad or sick, they pray, and even if it sounds strange – the Lord answers their prayers!

Winter is almost over, but now it's the hardest time for the families fed in the soup kitchen. All their in-

come, gained last summer from picking herbs and fruits in the forest, is spent... and the first „forest harvest“ for this year is still far... too far away.

The snow and the cold weather haven't gone yet. The biting cold is insidiously entering their houses



Sometimes it is difficult to understand if spoons are big or the children are too small

and the hunger is getting more and more unbearable. Praise God for the soup kitchen in church! It's warm there and the bean soup is incredibly tasty, when you eat it with friends. What is more – if you eat your bowl of soup first, then you will get one more!



After the meal comes the most interesting part of the day – praising the Lord with songs. He is the One Who loves them, takes care of them and heals them! „Love is the greatest... the highest... the widest... the deepest... The love of Jesus!“

The love of Jesus is reaching these children thanks to the donations and care of people living at thousands kilometers from here. Your support makes their lives easier during the winter. LIVING YOUR DREAM

And Transitions in the Life of a Leader

Were the topics of the pastors' conference Mission Possible held on March 1-3 in Bankia, Bulgaria, with Ed and Matt Huie as leading speakers, and more than 180 participants from all over the country.

We are deeply thankful to the Lord for this event which in itself was both a test and a miracle. A test – for our motives and commitment were tested. And a miracle – for after we showed readiness to sacrifice for the Lord, He provided the necessary funds and made it happen.

As a result, so many people registered that we had to look for a bigger hall which was nowhere to be found. At last, just 4 days before the conference, the Lord cancelled another event and provided the right hall for us.



The conference was very encouraging. Ed Huie ministered to the Bulgarian spiritual leaders both through his powerful word on how Ezekiel was transitioned from priestly to prophetic ministry, and through his powerful example of partnering with his son on the field.

Matt Huie rendered Rick Clendenon's teaching on the pit tests in the life of Joseph in a very mature and composed way, blending it with his own insights and personal illustrations which were particularly appealing for the younger generation of spiritual leaders.



Broken Heart Refuge

Broken Heart Refuge is the new ministry of Mission Possible, with women and children suffering from violence. The reconstruction of the building bought for shelter, has been going on during the cold winter months.

All sewage and plumbing pipes were installed.
Each room is already equipped with a bathroom.
All external walls have been thermally insulated.
Works are now going on:
Preparing the rooms to be painted
Setting of electrical wiring

Thanks to a donation, we could buy 30 doors for all the rooms in the building and tiles for the bathrooms.



To be able to complete the following building stage and have at least one floor ready for use, we need to buy:

- 20 PVC windows at the cost of - 4500 USD
- 14 doors for restrooms - 3500 USD
- 14 bathroom sets
(sinks, faucets, toilets) - 4900 USD
- Laminated parquet for 14 rooms - 4500 USD
